

Stemming from Swedish choral tradition, Swedish-Dutch singer Helena van Heel has developed into a many-sided mezzo-soprano with a velvety voice and ability to touch her audience deeply.

Helena has a wide-ranging repertoire from Baroque to contemporary music and she is highly praised for her expressive interpretations of the great works of J.S. Bach as well as chamber music performances and Lied-recitals. She works with the best ensembles and orchestras in the Netherlands.

New highlights are Helena's own productions in which existing compositions are combined with pieces specially written for her. Together with text writers, visual artists and directors, she has created an additional platform which gives shape to her love of music performance.

In December 2018 Helena released her first (Christmas) CD 'Ave maris stella'.
